The National Association of Black Accountants – Northwest Arkansas Chapter has scholarships available for college students. Enclosed you will find the scholarship application for the 2021 - 2022 school year. Students wishing to apply must:

1. Be **Currently** enrolled at a four-year accredited college or university in the State of Arkansas as a full time (12 semester hours or equivalent) undergraduate freshman, sophomore, junior or senior majoring in accounting, finance or business; A full-time **graduate** student (9 semester hours or equivalent) enrolled or accepted into a master’s-level business program; or, be a law student with a demonstrable interest in business law (for example, enrolled in/completed business law school courses and/or holds an undergraduate business degree).
2. Meet the minimum grade point average requirement of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) overall. Please provide a conversion of your grades to the “4.0 grading scale” if your college or university does not use this scale.

Applicants are required to submit:

- Completed application**
- Sealed official transcript**
- Resume**
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation:** One must be from a member of the business school faculty at your college/university. The other may be from a **non-relative** who is familiar with your academic, extracurricular, and/or professional performance (i.e. employer, advisor, etc.).
- Personal biography of 500 words or less:** Your biography should specifically discuss your career objectives, leadership abilities, community activities, background, and your involvement in NABA (if applicable).
- Recent business-appropriate headshot portrait** (for Chapter/NABA communications)
